Omaha Tennis Community,

The City of Omaha Parks, Recreation and Public Property department intends to make the following upgrades to the Koch Tennis Facility located at Tranquility Park:

- Reconstruction of six current tennis courts (\$840,000)
 - We will be replacing tennis courts 5, 6, 13, 14, 17 & 18
- Correct the drainage system around the courts so all courts can remain playable (\$30,000)
- \$870,000 Total commitment to this project

In addition, a FEMA project for replacing the fences around multiple courts is already underway and will take place during the construction of the new tennis courts.

We fully intend to budget funds that will allow us to continue the maintenance and upkeep to these courts once construction has been completed, to the best of our ability and around other department and city priorities.
